THE COST OF THE BATTLE

1.) _____

Romans 7:15 "I don't understand myself... I don't understand myself at all, for I really want to do what is right, but I can't. I do what I don't want to – what I hate."

2.) _____

Romans 7:16 "I know perfectly well what I'm doing is wrong. And my bad conscience proves that I agree with these laws I am breaking."

Romans 7:17 "If I do these bad things enough I get addicted to them. But I can't help myself because I'm no longer doing it. It's sin inside of me that's stronger than I am that makes me do these evil things."

Romans 7:18 "I know I'm rotten inside as far as my old sinful nature is concerned."

5.) _____

Romans 7:18 “No matter which way I turn I can’t make myself do right. I want to but I can’t. When I want to do good, I don’t; when I try not to do wrong, I do it anyway. If I’m doing what I don’t want to do, it’s plain to see where the trouble is: sin has me in its evil grasp.”

6.) _____

Romans 7:22 “It seems to be a fact of life that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. In my mind I want to be God’s willing servant, but instead I find myself still enslaved to sin.”
