## THE LOST ARE FOUND

Luke 14

Luke 19:10 *"The Son of man came to seek and to save the lost."*

Isaiah 53:6 *"All we like sheep have gone astray; we've turned everyone to his own way."*

### 1. Jesus came to \_\_\_\_\_

Matthew 4:23-24 *"Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people. News about him spread all over Syria, and people brought to him all who were ill with various diseases, those suffering severe pain, the demon possessed, those having seizures, and were paralyzed; and he healed them."*

Mark 1:40-42 *"A man with leprosy came to Jesus and begged him on his knees, 'If you are willing, you can make me clean.' Filled with compassion, Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. 'I am willing,' he said, 'Be clean!' Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cured."*

James 5:15 *"Believing-prayer will heal you, and Jesus will put you on your feet. If you've sinned, you will be forgiven – healed inside and out."*

Luke 4:18-19 *"The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach the good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for prisoners and recovery of sight to the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Then Jesus rolled up the scroll, and he handed it back to the attendant and sat down. Luke 5:23 *"Your sins are forgiven... Get up and walk... so that you may know that the Son of man has authority to forgive sins..." Then Jesus said to the paralyzed man, 'Get up, take up your mat and go home.' Immediately he stood up in front of everyone, took what he had been lying on and he went home praising God."*

Psalm 8:5 *"You crowned us with glory and honor."*

John 8:3 *"The Pharisees brought a woman caught in adultery to Jesus. They said to Jesus, 'This woman was caught in the act of adultery. In the Law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. What do you say?' They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing Jesus. Jesus bent down and started to write on the ground with his finger and when they kept on questioning him, he straightened up and said to them, 'If any one of you is without sin, let him be the first to throw a stone at her. Again he stooped down and wrote on the ground. At this, those who heard began to go away one at a time, the older ones first, until only Jesus was left, with the woman still standing there. Jesus straightened up and asked her, 'Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?' 'No one, sir,' she said.*

Romans 8:1 *"There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."*

Mathew 9:9-10 *"As Jesus was going down the road, he saw Matthew sitting at his tax-collection booth. 'Come, be my disciple' Jesus said. So Matthew got up, followed him. That night Matthew invited Jesus and his disciples to be his dinner guests, along with all his fellow tax collectors and many other notorious sinners."*
