2. In the beginning

- A. Words also found at the start of Genesis
- B. The beginning of John is a beginning before time
 - 1. It speaks of the beginners before the beginnings
 - 2. It reveals the beginners before they begin to create

3. The Word was with God and was God

- A. The Greek logos – The expression of a thought or way of thinking
- B. As the second member of the Trinity the Word expressed the Father's desire and plan _____ creation thus creating
- C. As the Word enters into creation He expresses the Father's heart and mind _____ creation – Hebrews 1:2-3
- D. The only biblical understanding of Jesus is that of Him as God

4. I'm going to re-arrange things a little to give a more chronological view

John 1:14, 4-5 *"The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed his glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. In him was life, and that life was the light of men. That light shines in the darkness, and yet the darkness did not overcome it."*

- A. The Word stepped into the natural world and became Jesus
- B. Eternal life came to confront death - John 10:10
- C. Light came to confront darkness - John 8:12
