THE CREED - WEEK 5 RAISED AND GLORIFIED

1. RESURRECTION

A. The reality - *1 Corinthians 15:3-6*

1. Received directly from Jesus by – *Galatians 1:12*

2. Big events - died, buried, raised, seen

3. Many opposing theories

a. Swoon theory

b. Hallucination theory

c. Impersonation theory

d. Spiritual resurrection theory

e. Theft theory

f. Unknown tomb theory

4. Why such opposition?

B. The centrality - *1 Corinthians 15:12-17*

1. There have always been disputes

2. Redemption is a package deal

C. Just to be clear about our terms

1. Resuscitation - Raised from the dead but eventually die again - Lazarus

2. Resurrection – Raised from the dead never to die again - Jesus

3. Rapture – Caught up to Jesus never having died and never dying –
1 Thessalonians 4:15-17

2. GLORIFICATION

- A. Resurrection happened from the grave to heaven
- B. Glorification is what happened upon arrival in heaven - *Ephesians 1:19-23*
- C. Both resurrection and glorification were accomplished by the greatest display of power ever
- D. Seated at God's right hand – The place of highest dignity and authority
- E. Named with the name above all names - *Philippians 2:9*
- F. Given to the Church as its head and over all thing
- G. Now we are one inseparable entity with and in Him

3. SIMULTANEOUSLY - *Ephesians 2:1-6*

- A. The great power didn't stop in raising Christ it continued to raise us up as well
- B. This is one of those already but not yet things
- C. Already accomplished but we are always moving into a greater experience of it

4. A NEW PERSPECTIVE

- A. Being in Christ and being raised with Him gives us the possibility of living in and from that reality
- B. It gives us the opportunity of seeing things from a different perspective
- C. It allows us to see things the way God sees them
- D. When we see things the way God sees them our response to those things will be same as god's response
