Matthew 5:48 (NIV) "Be perfect as your Heavenly Father is perfect."

☑ Treat your kids the same way God treats you.

Psalm 103:13 (NIV) "As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him. For He knows how we are formed. He remembers we are only dust.

IF I'M GOING TO BE A GOOD PARENT:

1. I must learn to understand my children.

Proverbs 24:3 (GN) "Homes are built on the foundation of wisdom and understanding."

Proverbs 14:29 (NIV) "A man of understanding has patience."

2. I must learn to accept my children.

Psalm 127:3 (NIV) "Children are a gift from God; they are his reward."

Romans 15:7 (NIV) "Accept one another just as Christ has accepted you."

3. I must learn to discipline my children.

Hebrews 12:6 (NIV) "The Lord disciplines those whom He loves."

If I don't discipline my children, then two things are true:

☑ It proves that I really don't love my children.

Proverbs 13:24 (CEV) "If you love your children, you will correct them; if you don't love them, you won't correct them".

☑ I'm participating in their <u>destruction</u>.

Proverbs 19:18 (GN) "Discipline your children while they are young enough to learn. If you don't you're helping them destroy themselves."

☑The purpose of punishment is to <u>inflict penalty</u>☑ The purpose of discipline is to <u>promote growth</u>
☑ The focus of punishment is on the <u>on the past</u>☑ The focus of discipline is on the <u>on the future</u>
☑ The attitude in punishment is <u>anger</u>☑ The attitude in discipline is <u>love</u>
☑The result of punishment is <u>fear</u> , <u>guilt and more anger</u> ☑The result of discipline is <u>security</u>
1 John 4:18 (NIV) "There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out all fear, because fear has to do with punishment."
