Mark 12:30-31 (NIV) *“Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength and love your neighbor as yourself. There is no greater commandment than these.”*

☑ **An unclear purpose.**

☑ **An unemployed talent.**

1 Corinthians 7:17 (NIV) *“Each one of you should live his life with the gifts that the Lord has given him.”*

☑ **An unbalanced schedule.**

1 Timothy 4:7 (PH) *“Take the time and the trouble to keep yourself spiritually fit.”*

James 1:22 (NIV) - *“Be doers of the word, and not hearers only”*

☑ **An unconfessed sin.**

Psalms 38:4 (NIV) *“My guilt has overwhelmed me like a burden too heavy to bear. I am bowed down and brought low.”*

1 John 1:9 (CEV) *“If we confess our sins, God can be trusted to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”*
