LIFE POINT: The value you place on something is shown by <u>what you'll give up</u> for it.

Matthew 13:44-46 (NLT)

Parables of the Hidden Treasure and the Pearl

"The Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure that a man discovered hidden in a field. In his excitement, he hid it again and sold everything he owned to get enough money to buy the field. Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a merchant on the lookout for choice pearls. When he discovered a pearl of great value, he sold everything he owned and bought it!"

Matthew 13:51 (NIV) "'Have you understood all these things?' Jesus asked. 'Yes,' they replied."

The famous Roman historian Pliny the elder said:

"The first place and the topmost rank among all things of price is held by pearls ... Their whole value lies in their brilliance, size, roundness, smoothness, and weight ... There have been two pearls that were the largest in the whole of history; both were owned by Cleopatra ... they had come down to her through the hands of the kings of the East."

LIFE POINT: God is not upset at you because you want to be happy.
