Open the Bible together and read John 2:1-11 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

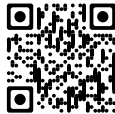
Engagement Questions

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them one way you’ve seen them be joyful.



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: “Who are the people who help you find joy?”



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “Who is someone you know who seems joyful?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “Jesus, thank You for showing us what it looks like to live joyfully. Help us to live like You.”
