Open the Bible together and read 2 Chronicles 10 (supporting: Proverbs 13:20) or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

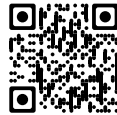
Engagement Questions

Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "Who are some of your closest friends right now? What do you like the most about them?"
