As your kid starts their day, tell them about

Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the
table answer this question: “Who are some
wise people in your life?”



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “Who are
some of your closest friends right now?
What do you like the most about them?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, surround us
with wise people and bring wise people
into our lives to help us, guide us, and
discover more about You.”
