Open the Bible together and read Luke 4:1-13 (Supporting: Matthew 4:1-11) or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

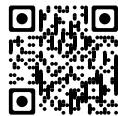
Engagement Questions

Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “When have you seen someone do something good lately—either through an action or something they said?”
