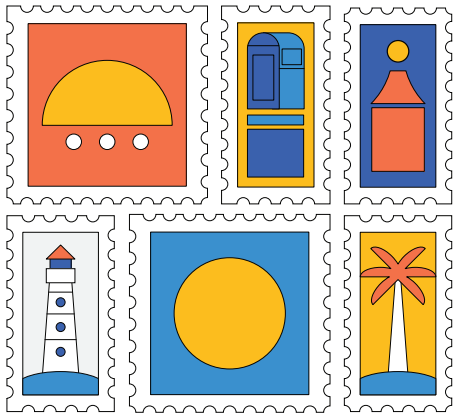




## Special Delivery: No postage required

Open the Bible together and read James 1:17a or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

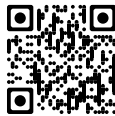
### Engagement Questions
