ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, tell them about a time when you saw them be kind or comfort someone, and how much you admire that.



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: “What helps you remember that God is with you?”



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “Who is someone you know who makes people feel welcome?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, sometimes we feel like we’re alone. Help us to remember that You are always with us.”
