	<b>Philippians 4:6-7 (NKJV)</b> "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."
	☑ With thanksgiving – because we believe God will hear and respond
	James 1:6 (NKJV) "But let him ask in faith"

	☑ To help or rescue someone you happen upon
	☑ Pray for someone or some situation that you become aware of
	☑ God is looking for someone - <i>Isaiah 59:16, Ezekiel 22:30 (NKJV)</i>
	☑ Picture of an intercessor - Colossians 4:12-13 (NKJV)

☑ To speak for God and with God into a particular situation	
<b>Job 22 (AMP)</b> <sup>25</sup> "And make the Almighty your gold and [the Lord] your precious silver treasure, <sup>26</sup> Then you will have delight in the Almighty, and you will lift up your face to God. <sup>27</sup> You will make your prayer to Him, and He will hear you, and you will pay your vows. <sup>28</sup> You shall also decide and decree a thing, and it shall be established for you; and the light [of God's favor] shall shine upon your ways."	
☑ God wants a people who will declare His will in the earth	
<b>Amos 3:8 (NKJV)</b> "A lion has roared! Who will not fear? The Lord GOD has spoken! Who can but prophesy?"	
☑ Jesus taught us to declare God's will - Matthew 6:9-10 (NKJV)	
Habakkuk 3:17-19 (NKJV) <sup>17</sup> "Though the fig tree may not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines; though the labor of the olive may fail, And the fields yield no food; though the flock may be cut off from the fold, and there be no herd in the stalls- <sup>18</sup> Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation. <sup>19</sup> The LORD God is my strength; He will make my feet like deer's feet, and He will make me walk on my high hills."  ☑ We can see this as simply resignation ☑ But Habakkuk has heard from the Lord  Habakkuk 1:5 (NKJV) "Look among the nations and watch Be utterly astound-	
ed! For I will work a work in your days Which you would not believe, though it were told you."
