Open the Bible together and read Matthew 14:22-33 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

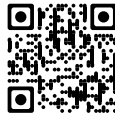
### Engagement Questions

# Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



### Morning Time

When you go into your child’s room, cuddle them and say: “Good morning, [child’s name]! How are you feeling today? (Pause.) Happy, sad, afraid, excited? No matter how you feel, Jesus is always a good friend.”



### Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: “Dear God, thank You that Jesus is always a good friend and that we can talk to Him whenever we feel afraid.”



### Drive Time

While on the go, take turns naming a few things that make you feel afraid. (Yes, grown-ups feel afraid sometimes too!) Talk about how Jesus was a good friend to Peter when Peter was afraid of the wind and Jesus will be a good friend to us too.



### Bath Time

Add a toy boat and some toy people to bath time. As your child plays, talk about how Jesus was a good friend and helped Peter when Peter felt afraid.
