Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child’s room, cuddle them and say: “Good morning, [child’s name]! Rain or shine, today is going to be a great day, because Jesus is always a good friend!”



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: “Dear God, Jesus is the best friend ever! Jesus loves us when we’re happy. Jesus loves us when we’re sad. Jesus loves us all the time! We are so glad You gave us Jesus!”



Drive Time

While on the go, name as many things as you can that make you feel happy. Talk about how Jesus made Zacchaeus happy when He went to Zacchaeus’ house.



Bath Time

Encourage your child to use bath crayons to draw happy faces on the tub. Talk about how happy Zacchaeus was when Jesus told him He was going to Zacchaeus’ house!
